# Summary of Project

- Educate community about city needs and funding limitations.
- Understanding appetite among all audiences for policy alternatives.
- Public education campaign about specific solutions and alternatives.

# Schedule

- Ongoing: public awareness about city needs, funding constraints and goals/objectives.
- April – June: focus group/survey data on narrowed policy options.
- June – Sept.: public education/feedback on recommended alternatives

# Pros and Cons

## PRO

- Keeps community needs and QCI work front and center.
- Options discussion = transparency and dialogue.
- Data-driven decisions

## CON

- Boring background noise.
- Lack of specifics/ direction = negative reaction
- Sensitivity to ballot issues/election rules
