AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2024 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$29,899 AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

Whereas the City of Commerce City (City) was awarded a grant through the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program to be used for the Drone Operations Program and Bike Patrol Unit Program to protect the safety of Commerce City residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2024 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado, is amended to recognize Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program in the amount of \$29,899, and to appropriate such funds in the Grant Fund (Fund 180) for a total of \$29,899.

Section 2. This ordinance is in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare of the public.
