A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT WITH MATRIX DESIGN GROUP, INC. FOR THE FINAL ENGINEERING DESIGN OF THE E. 56TH AVENUE RECONSTRUCTION, BETWEEN BRIGHTON BLVD AND VASQUEZ BLVD PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City") desires to widen and reconstruct E. 56th Ave. generally from Brighton Blvd. to Vasquez Blvd. consistent with the scope of work detailed in 2022-19-PW, Final Engineering Design for E. 56th Ave. Reconstruction Between Brighton Blvd and Vasquez Blvd ("Project");

WHEREAS, the City has engaged in a formal, competitive bidding process consistent with applicable requirements to select a contractor to complete the Project, and, after reviewing all the bids, City staff has determined the lowest responsive and responsible bidder whose bid provides the best value to the City is Matrix Design Group, Inc., ("Contractor"); and

WHEREAS, the cost of the Project to the City will exceed \$250,000.00 and, pursuant to the City's procurement policies and the City Manager's commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest. Specifically, the City Council hereby finds and determines the award of the contract for the Project to the Contractor is and shall be in the best interests of the residents of the City.
- **SECTION 2. Award of Contract.** The award of the contract for the Project to the Contractor is hereby approved subject to successful finalization of an appropriate contract on terms acceptable to the City Manager. This resolution shall not be deemed to grant any right or interest in the award of a contract to Matrix Design Group, Inc. All rights and interests shall be defined exclusively by the terms and conditions set forth in the written contract.
- **SECTION 3. Authorization to Negotiate.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and finalize the details of a contract with the Contractor, including final pricing and payment terms, consistent with the services agreement with the Contractor.
- **SECTION 4. Execution of Attestation.** Upon successful finalization of the contract and approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the contract on behalf of the City.
