AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2024 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF EARLY CHILDHOOD (CDEC) GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,023 FOR CHILD CARE STABILIZATION AND CAPACITY BUILDING AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, childcare stabilization, capacity building, and related childcare programming is a priority of the Colorado Department of Early Childhood (CDEC);

WHEREAS, the CDEC continues to award grants to eligible entities that provide licensed and applicable services, and ensure childcare providers have the resources they need;

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City has been awarded grant funds in the amount of \$12,023 from the Colorado Department of Early Childhood; and

WHEREAS, funding in the amount of \$7,023 was awarded to fund licensed summer camp program costs, and \$5,000 was awarded for classroom furnishings and educational materials for indoor and outdoor classroom spaces.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** An amendment is made to the 2024 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Colorado Department of Early Childhood Grant in the amount of \$12,023 to be used for licensed summer camp program costs, and purchase new classroom furnishings and educational materials for our indoor and outdoor classroom spaces, and the expenditure thereof is hereby authorized. (Fund 180)

**SECTION 2**. This ordinance is in the best interests of the City and the public safety.
