

Purpose and Need

- ➤ The City is in the process of updating the Comprehensive Plan
- ➤ One of the components of the Comprehensive Plan is the Transportation Master Plan (TMP)
- ➤ The TMP has not been updated since 2010
- ➤ It is best practice for the City to update the TMP regularly over time.
- ➤ The TMP provides a vision for the future transportation network in Commerce City.
- ➤ The transportation network is a system of planned and improved vehicular, bicycle, pedestrian and bus facilities that will assure residents, workers, and visitors high-quality mobility and access for all of their travel needs.
- The plan will help elected and appointed officials, in addition to Staff, to make many decisions about future land use and transportation for the city

Proposal Process

➤ Advertised a Request for Proposals (RFP) from December 6, 2023 to January 18, 2024

➤ The City received two proposals

> Proposals ranked by a Staff committee

Felsburg Holt & Ullevig (FHU) was the higher ranked responded
