

**RESOLUTION SETTING OIL AND GAS PERMIT APPLICATION FEE AND
AMENDING DIRECTORY OF CITY FEES AND CHARGES**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 1891 amending the City's Land Development Code (the "LDC") relating to oil and gas exploration, an extensive new permitting and application process will be created;

WHEREAS, the City will incur certain costs for administration of these new processes, including permit application review;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the Oil and Gas Permit Application fee authorized in Article V of the LDC is reasonable and necessary to defray the administrative costs incurred by the City in reviewing and processing the Oil and Gas Permit Application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Oil and Gas Permit Application fee authorized in Article V of the LDC is hereby established in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00).
2. The Directory of City Fees and Charges is hereby amended to reflect the fee established herein.
3. This Resolution 2012-25 shall become effective upon only final passage and adoption of Ordinance 1891.
