Background

- Issue 2K approved by voters Nov. 5
 - Increase 3.5% sales and use tax by one percent
 - Estimated to generate \$9-10 million in first year
 - Effective Jan. 1, 2014
- Committed to Five Projects in Five Years
 - New recreation center
 - Expanded Tower Road
 - New outdoor pool
 - Three new neighborhood parks
 - New additions to existing recreation center



Background

- Voter-approved dedicated funding source for new parks, recreation and road projects
- Not just capital, but operations and maintenance on the new projects
- Result of two-year, community-driven process to identify how to implement programs and services that address growing population needs, achieve vision and build a better Commerce City
- Update includes other major capital projects not part of voter-approved revenues

- Build high quality facilities to lower their long-term maintenance costs
- Spend taxpayer dollars wisely and transparently
- Complete projects on time

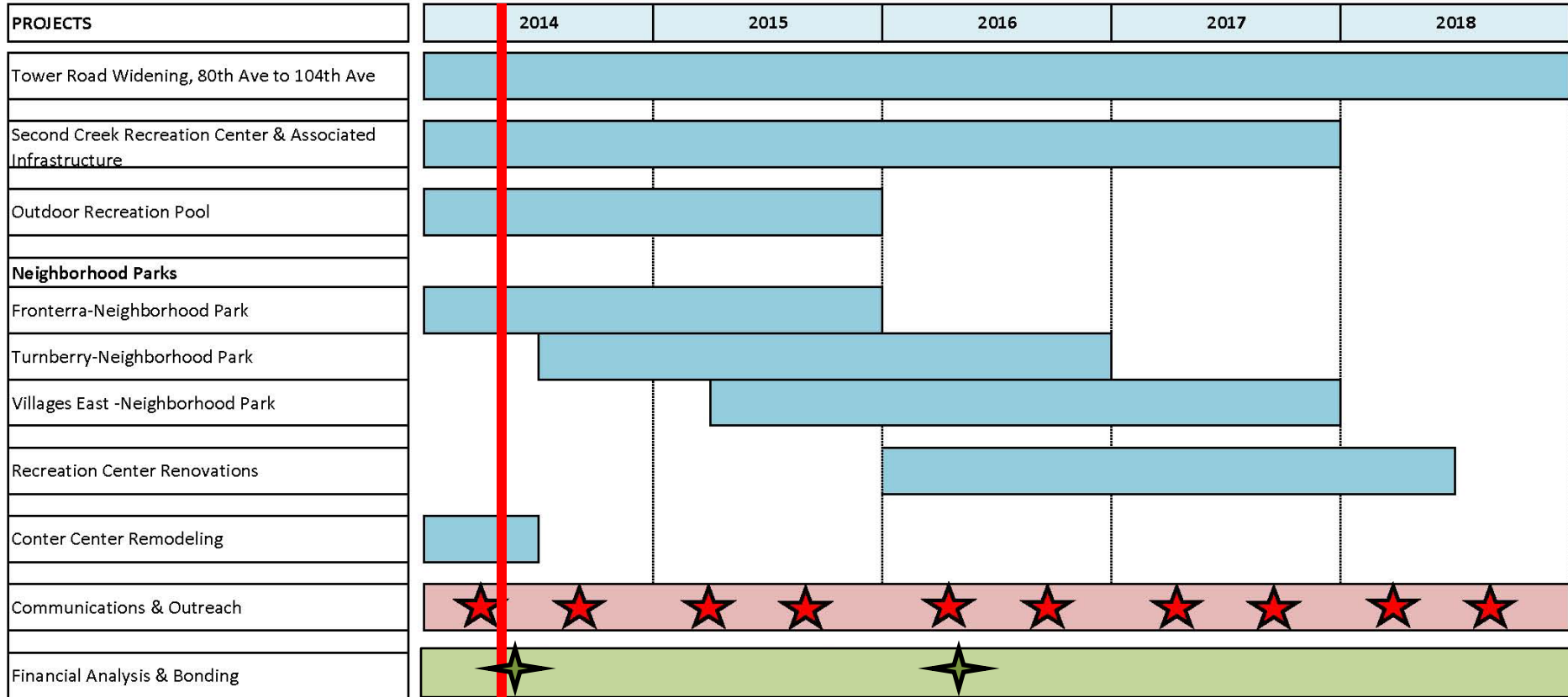

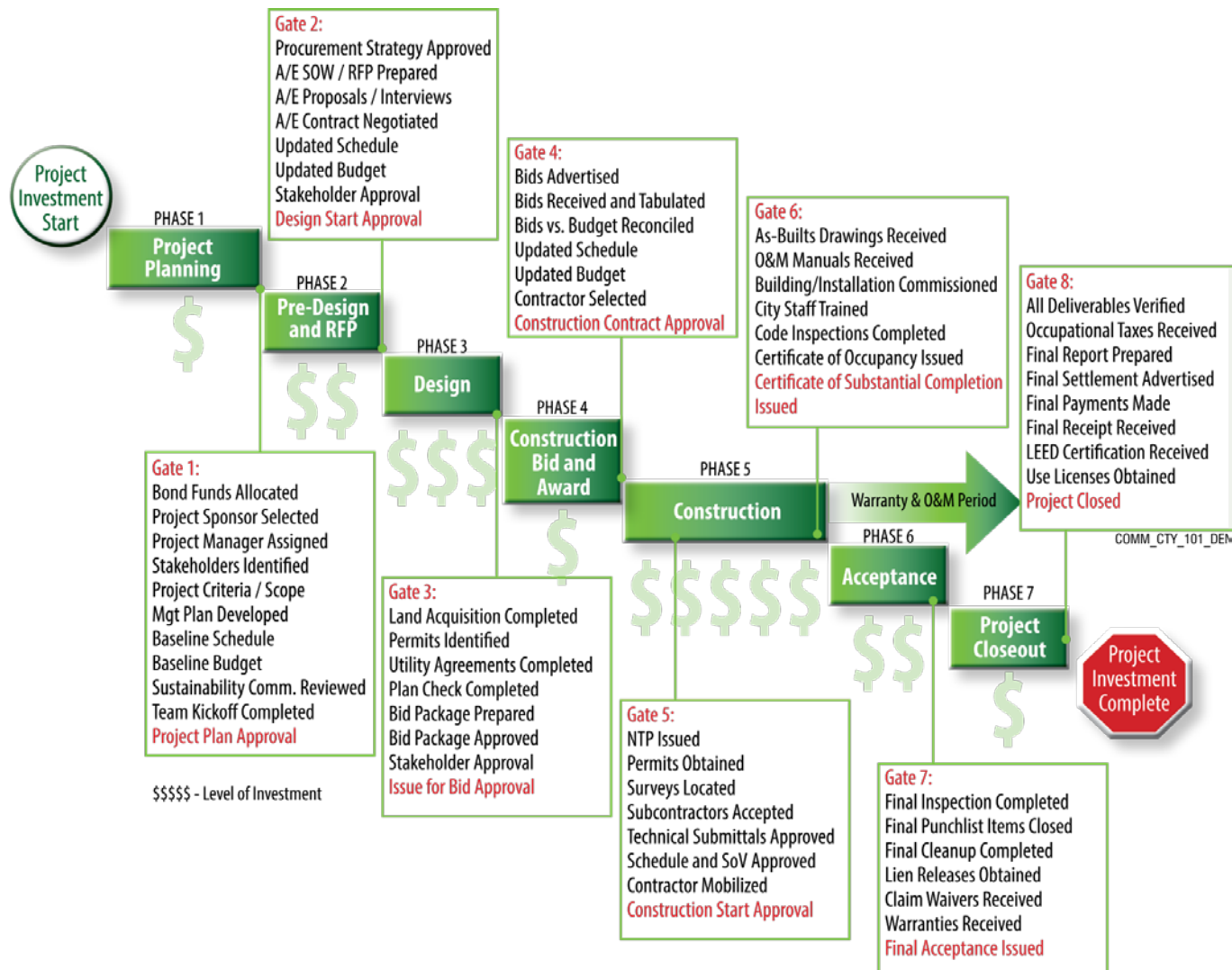


Denotes regularly scheduled council update

 - 2014 YTD (March): \$ 20,050.00



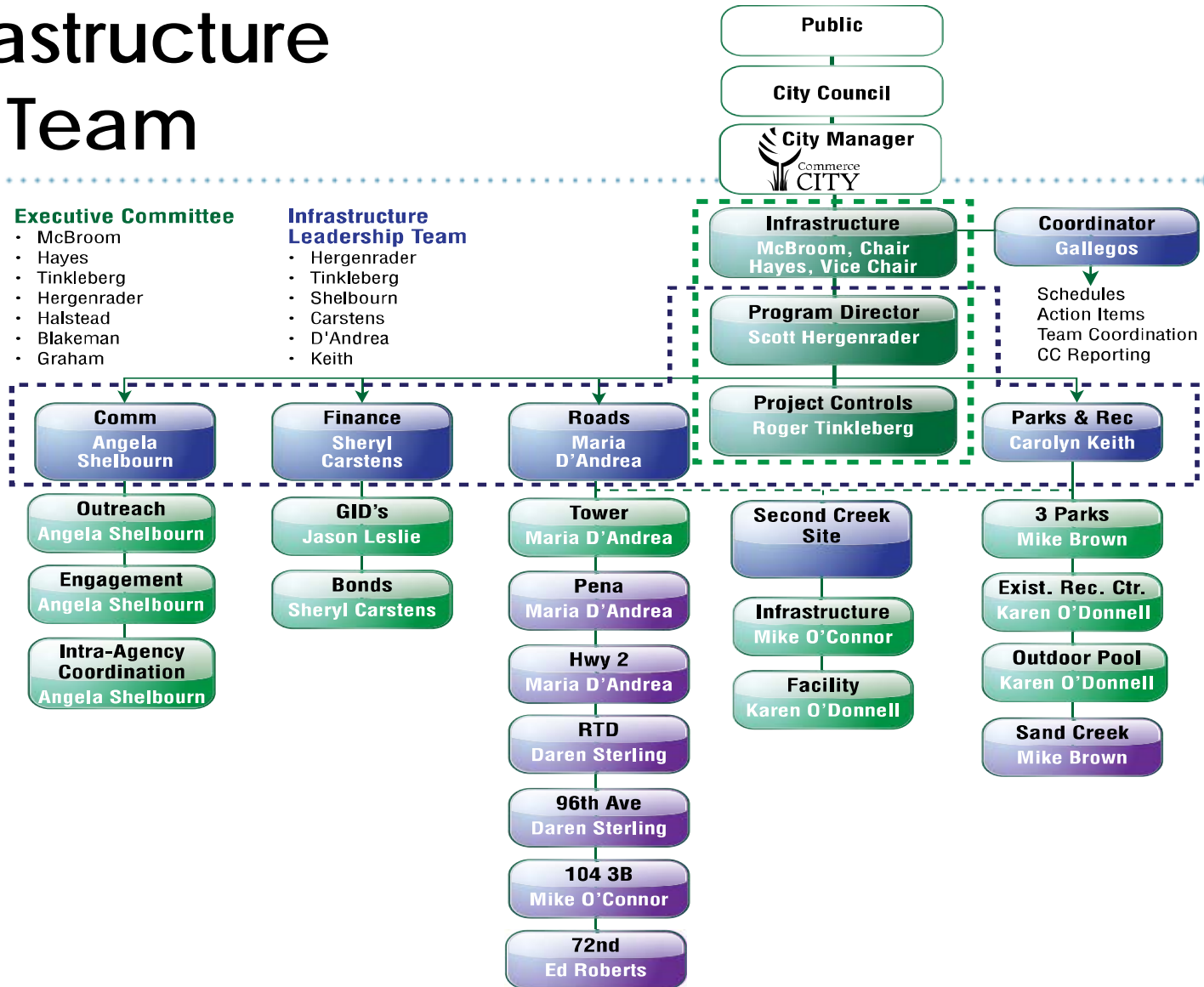
