Sec. 7-1003. Operation of motorized vehicles; parking on or adjacent to parks; exceptions.

- (a) It is unlawful for any unauthorized person to operate any motorized vehicle <u>or ATV</u> on or within any park property except as expressly provided in subsection 11-2100 of this Code.
- (b) It is unlawful to park any trailer or motorized vehicle <u>or ATV</u> on park property, except where specifically authorized by the city, or in such a manner as to create a hazard to natural resources or vehicular, pedestrian, equestrian or bicycle traffic or to obstruct emergency vehicle/equipment access.
- (c) It is unlawful to wash, service or repair any vehicle within any park property without prior authorization by the city.
- (d) Except for the vehicles of government employees engaged in official business or when specifically authorized by the city, it is unlawful to park any motorized vehicle or trailer, whether attended or unattended: (1) when the owner or operator is not using the park property; (2) on park property between 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.; or (3) where posted, on the portion of any public street abutting any park property between 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. Any vehicle in violation of this subsection shall be deemed abandoned and subject to immediate towing, impoundment, or relocation. The violation of this subsection is a civil infraction.
- (e) Authority to designate areas.
 - (1) The city manager is hereby authorized to designate any areas within park property for the operation and parking of motorized vehicles <u>and ATVs</u> and to close or restrict access to such areas.
 - (2) The areas in which the operation and parking of motorized vehicles <u>or ATVs</u> is authorized shall be clearly marked with signs giving notice that such operation or parking is permitted.
- (f) Minimum Fine. Any violation of subsection (a) resulting from the use of an ATV as defined by section 11-2100 of this Code, or a motorcycle as defined by the Model Traffic Code, shall result in a minimum fine of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00).
