## REQUEST

Adopt a resolution to award a professional services agreement with Hoffmann Parker Wilson & Carberry, P.C. to act as Independent Ethics Counsel.

## BACKGROUND

On May 19, 2025, City Council adopted a new Ethics Code via Ordinance 2672 on second and final reading.

Section 2-6013 of the Ethics Code establishes an Independent Ethics Counsel. The Ethics Code requires that City Council contract with a licensed attorney to practice law in Colorado and that the contract shall be a term of five (5) years. This resolution awards the contract to Hoffmann Parker Wilson & Carberry, P.C.

The Independent Ethics Counsel shall be an attorney licensed to practice law in Colorado.”</p>
