A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH FELSBURG, HOLT & ULLEVIG (FHU) FOR GRANT WRITING SERVICES

NO. 2024-136

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City"), conducted a competitive procurement process through a Request for Proposals for grant writing services in the Fall 2023;

WHEREAS, the City selected and contracted with Felsburg, Holt & Ullevig ("FHU") in January 2024 to provide grant writing services focused on transportation and infrastructure efforts ("Services");

WHEREAS, the agreement with FHU expires on December 31, 2024 and authorizes limited expenditures of \$100,000;

WHEREAS, the City Council has allocated \$1,000,000 in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding to grant writing services that must be expended by December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to extend the contract with FHU through December 31, 2026 and increase the not to exceed compensation in the contract to \$400,000 for grant writing services, which will now result in more than \$250,000 in costs to the City, and pursuant to the City's procurement policies and the City Manager's commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.
- **SECTION 2. Award of Contract.** The award of the contract amendment for the Services to FHU is hereby approved subject to successful finalization of an appropriate contract on terms acceptable to the City Manager. This resolution shall not be deemed to grant any right or interest in the award of a contract to FHU. All rights and interests shall be defined exclusively by the terms and conditions set forth in the written contract.
- **SECTION 3.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and finalize the details of a contract amendment with FHU, including final pricing and payment terms, consistent the services agreement with FHU.
- **SECTION 4.** Upon successful approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk to attest to the amendment, on behalf of the City.
