

**A RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT TO TYLER TECHNOLOGIES FOR THE
PURCHASE AND USE OF BRAZOS E-TICKETING SOFTWARE AND RELATED
SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) has previously contracted with Tyler Technologies, Inc. (“Tyler”) via a Licenses and Services Agreement for licensing, maintenance, and support for software, which includes Brazos eCitation software (“Products and Services”);

WHEREAS, the City would like to continue to use the software uninterrupted, but now the procurement amount will likely exceed \$250,000;

WHEREAS, the City Manager has approved of the procurement without competition pursuant to the City’s Procurement Policy; and

WHEREAS, the cost to the City of the purchase will likely exceed \$250,000.00 and, pursuant to the City’s procurement policies and the City Manager’s commitment to the City Council, the City Council must approve any procurement in excess of \$250,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Award of Contract. The award of the contract for licensing, maintenance, and support for Brazos eCitation software and related services to Tyler Technologies, Inc. (“Contractor”) is hereby approved subject to successful finalization of an appropriate contract on terms acceptable to the City Manager. This resolution shall not be deemed to grant any right or interest in the award of a contract to Contractor. All rights and interests shall be defined exclusively by the terms and conditions set forth in the written contract.

SECTION 2. Authorization to Negotiate. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and finalize the details of a contract with the Contractor, including final pricing and payment terms, and any amendment thereto.

SECTION 3. Execution and Attestation. Upon successful finalization of the contract and approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute, and the City Clerk to attest, the contract or any amendment thereto on behalf of the City.
