

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE CITY OF COMMERCE
CITY PERMANENT ARBITRATION PANEL**

WHEREAS, Section 21.12 of the City Charter requires the City to create and keep a permanent panel of at least three arbitrators to decide any unresolved issues between the City and the employee organization after the 30-day contract negotiation period concludes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council created a four member panel in 2000; and

WHEREAS, the City recently learned that two of the arbitrators on the City's panel are now deceased; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to appoint two new members to the permanent arbitration panel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Philip Tamoush, a member of the National Academy of Arbitrators, and Francis Raucci, a member of the American Arbitration Association are hereby appointed to the City of Commerce City's permanent arbitration panel.
