

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING COUNCIL POLICY #CP-16 TO FORMALLY ADOPT  
BOB'S RULES OF ORDER FOR COLORADO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (2023)**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City is authorized to adopt procedures to govern the conduct of meetings and rules governing the decision-making process;

WHEREAS, City Council is interested in formally adopting procedural rules of order with the intent that doing so will assist in the running of more efficient meetings with clear procedural rules; and

WHEREAS, City Council has determined that Bob's Rules of Order for Colorado Local Governments (2023) is the appropriate procedural rules to govern City Council meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

**SECTION 2. Amendments.**

Council Policy #CP-16(A)(3) is added to read as follows:

13. Procedural Rules. *Bob's Rules of Order for Colorado Local Governments (2023)* is adopted as the rules of order for Council meetings. In cases where the adopted edition of *Bob's Rules of Order* is inconsistent with the City Charter or City codes, the City Charter and City codes shall govern and control.
