## **REQUEST**

Approve a budget ordinance to amend the 2025 budget of the City of Commerce City to recognize Fiscal Year 2024 Congressionally Directed Spending funds in the amount of \$4,116,000 for the Chambers Road Widening project.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The City of Commerce City ("City") applied for Fiscal Year 2024 ("FY 24") Congressionally Directed Spending funds for the Chambers Road Widening Project ("project"). In 2024, the City was awarded \$4,116,00 for the project. Congressionally Directed Spending is federal funding passed-through the Colorado Department of Transportation ("CDOT"). The City is providing \$1,029,000 in match funding from the Chambers Road Widening Fund.
