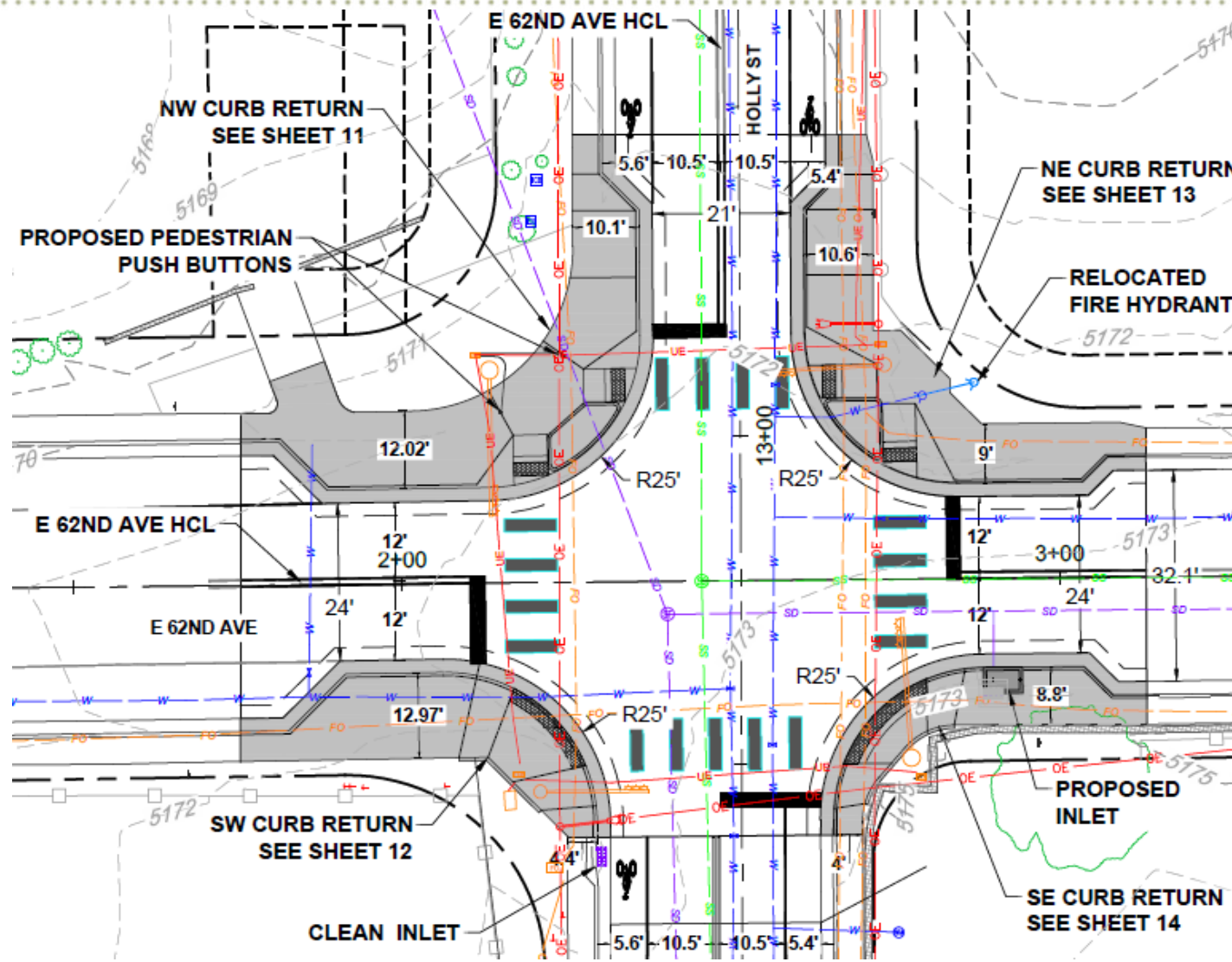
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Proposed Improvements

- ❖ Traffic Calming – Islands to slow traffic and provide sanctuaries for pedestrians and bicyclists crossing the intersection.
- ❖ Minor Drainage and Utility – Relocating storm sewer inlet and fire hydrant at intersection to new locations which will accommodate necessary drainage and provide a safe distance from traffic with new traffic alignment and hydrant placement.
- ❖ Pedestrian – Traffic signal modifications to include pedestrian push buttons allowing sufficient crossing time and safe pedestrian movements across the intersection.
- ❖ Striping – Adequate bike lanes will be established from E. 60th Avenue to E. 64th Ave. as a part of the project increasing multi-modal connectivity for this area of the city.
