- 3. Braconier Plumbing and Heating Co, Inc has been engaged in HVAC and Plumbing maintenance since 1906. Braconier has been incorporated under the same name for 117 years.
- 4. Braconier Plumbing and Heating has <u>not</u> been terminated from any contract or project in the last five years.
- 5. Braconier Plumbing and Heating has <u>not</u> been party to litigation related to our work in the last five years.
- 6. Braconier Plumbing and Heating has twelve (13) HVAC technicians and eight (8) Plumbing technicians.
- 7. Braconier Plumbing and Heating <u>can</u> provide 24-hour "on call" emergency coverage.
- 8. Braconier Plumbing and Heating on call response time varies on time of day and type of emergency. Typically Braconier classifies work under priority numbers.
 - P-1 Dire Emergency that requires imidiate action. (2 hour response time)
 - <u>P-2</u> Not an emergency but requires action. (24 hours to two days response time)
 - P-3 Not an emergency but can be scheduled. (24 hours to 3 weeks).

Braconier Plumbing and Heating hours of operation are Monday – Friday 7:00am to 5:00 pm.

Saturdays are "on call after hours" and will be charged at the overtime rate.

Sundays and Holidays are "on call after hours" and will be charged at the double time rate.
