

ORDINANCE NO. 2369

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2022 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE ADAMS COUNTY OPEN SPACE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,500,000 FOR THE BUFFALO RUN GOLF COURSE IRRIGATION SYSTEM AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

WHEREFORE, the City of Commerce City (“City”), acting by and through its City Council, approved in 2018, a plan to replace the irrigation system of the Buffalo Run Golf Course (“Buffalo Run Irrigation System”); and

WHEREFORE, in order to close a gap in budgeted funds for the Buffalo Run Irrigation System, the City submitted a grant application, subsequently approved by the Adams County Open Space Advisory Board on November 17, 2021, in the amount of \$1,500,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. An amendment is made to the 2022 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from Adams County Open Space Grant in the amount of \$1,500,000. The funds are to be used for replacement of the Buffalo Run Irrigation System Project and the expenditure thereof is hereby authorized. (Fund 395).

SECTION 2. This ordinance is in the best interests of the City and the public health, safety, and welfare and in the general public.
