

**RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
FOR HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL ROUNDUP PROGRAM WITH TRI-COUNTY
HEALTH DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, Tri-County Health Department (“Tri-County Health”) has proposed to the City of Commerce City (“City”) a safe and viable disposal option for hazardous household waste through the Adams County Household Chemical Roundup Program (“HCR Program”);

WHEREAS, the City and Tri-County Health desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto (“Intergovernmental Agreement”), to facilitate the City’s participation in the HCR Program for up to six (6) years;

WHEREAS, approval of the City Council is required because the Intergovernmental Agreement contemplates a direct monetary payment exceeding \$100,000.00 over the possible term of the agreement, pursuant to Section 4-201(b) of the Commerce City Revised Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that participation in the HCR Program will assist in protecting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of City and desires to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Intergovernmental Agreement is hereby approved, substantially in the form attached hereto.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign and attest the Intergovernmental Agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto, in the City’s Attorney’s opinion, on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
