## A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE BLUE RIBBON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE AND RATIFYING THEIR WORK THROUGH SEPTEMBER 26, 2022

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce City ("City Council"), by Resolution 2021-58, resolved and passed on August 16, 2021, created the Blue Ribbon Economic Development Committee ("Committee"), as an advisory commission and charged the Committee to "evaluate and advise the City Council regarding economic development best practices and strategies to attract resident- and visitor-serving businesses, primarily, and to elevate Commerce City's profile from an economic development perspective.";

WHEREAS, the Committee was originally directed to complete its tasks and make its final recommendations to the City Council and dissolve by no later than June 30, 2022;

WHEREAS, by subsequent action of Council on June 6, 2022, additional meetings and actions of the Committee were authorized;

WHEREAS, the work of the Committee, specifically the final recommendations, is scheduled to be reported to Council on September 26, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to extend the term of the Committee through and including the date of the Committee's reporting of its findings and recommendations to the City Council, including the ratification of Committee's actions and work previous to that time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1. Findings.** The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

**SECTION 2.** Extension and Ratification. The term of the Blue Ribbon Economic Development Committee ("Committee") is hereby extended through and including September 26, 2022. All work of the Committee, including conducting meetings and creating work product, and the authority therefore, to the extent inconsistent with Resolution 2021-52, is hereby ratified and retroactively authorized.
