AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2023 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, BY APPROPRIATING A PORTION OF THE UNENCUMBERED FUND BALANCE OF THE FLEET MANAGEMENT FUND AND TRANSFERRING PORTIONS OF THE UNENCUMBERED FUND BALANCES IN THE POLICE FORFEITURE - FEDERAL AND POLICE FORFEITURE - STATE FUNDS TO THE FLEET MANAGEMENT FUND TO BE USED FOR THE PURCHASE OF A BEARCAT FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$280,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

WHEREAS, the City has reserves not anticipated or appropriated at the time of the adoption of the 2023 City budget for these new appropriations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to authorize the expenditure of these funds by enacting a supplemental budget appropriation to the 2023 City budget as authorized by Section 12-9(a) of the City Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated into the 2023 budget from the unencumbered fund balance in the Fleet Management Fund an amount of \$207,000 to be used for costs associated with the purchase of a BearCat for the Public Safety Department.
- **Section 2.** An amendment is made to the 2023 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado by transferring \$64,100 from the Police Forfeiture-Federal Fund (Fund 160) to the Fleet Management Fund (Fund 630) to be used for costs associated with the purchase of a BearCat for the Public Safety Department.
- **Section 3.** An amendment is made to the 2023 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado by transferring \$8,900 from the Police Forfeiture-State Fund (Fund 150) to the Fleet Management Fund (Fund 630) to be used for costs associated with the purchase of a BearCat for the Public Safety Department.
- **Section 4.** The expenditure of the funds herein transferred and appropriated is hereby authorized.
  - **Section 5.** This ordinance is in the best interests of the City and the general public.
