

A RESOLUTION AMENDING COUNCIL POLICY # CP-2, COUNCIL NORMS AND STANDARDS OF CONDUCT, SECTION D AND RELATED PROVISIONS, COUNCIL COMMITTEES

NO. 2023-079

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Commerce City (“City Council”) enacted certain policies pursuant to Section 4.27 of the City Charter, which provides that the City Council “shall determine its own organization, rules and order of business ...”; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Council Policy #CP-2 to (1) require that all council committees, with the exception of the Legislative Committee, consist of only three councilmembers; (2) provide for two additional standing council committees, the City Council Retreat and City Council Orientation Committee; and (3) establish term limits for councilmembers appointed to council committees, unless no other councilmember has volunteered to take those councilmembers’ place.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this resolution are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This resolution is found to be necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and in the public interest.

SECTION 2. Amendments. Council Policy #CP – 2, Council Committees is amended as outline in Exhibit A.
