WHEREAS, Commerce City entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Tri-County Health Department in July 2019 for inspection oversight at the Towers Landfill;

WHEREAS, the Tri-County Health Department has now disbanded;

WHEREAS, landfill inspection can be performed by local and state agencies;

WHEREAS, the state has a limited number of inspectors and allows local governments to have health departments to perform those inspections;

WHEREAS, Adams County Health Department (ACHD) has agreed to perform those services on behalf of Commerce City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City is desirous of entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement for landfill inspection services with Adams County Health Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:
