AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2015 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY INCREASING THE BUDGETED REVENUES IN THE CAPITAL EXPENDITURES FUND BY \$15,700,000 FOR THE RECOGNITION OF THE PAYMENT FROM COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CDOT) FOR OWNERSHIP AND MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITIES OF 8.676 MILES OF STATE HIGHWAY AND THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The 2015 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado is amended by increasing the appropriated revenues in the amount of Fifteen Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$15,700,000) for recognition of the payment from CDOT for ownership and maintenance responsibilities of 8.676 miles of State Highway 2.
