AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2021 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE ADAMS COUNTY OPEN SPACE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$960,000 FOR THE MONACO PARK RENOVATION PROJECT AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. An amendment is made to the 2021 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from Adams County Open Space Grant in the amount of \$960,000. The funds are to be used for the Monaco Park Renovation Project and the expenditure thereof is hereby authorized. (Fund 395).
- 2. The Mayor is authorized and directed to sign, and the City Clerk to attest, an intergovernmental agreement with Adams County to implement the grant.
