## BACKGROUND/REQUEST

At the July 28 Study Session, the City Council held a discussion on the Operating Funding Priorities for the 2026 Budget Requests. The City Council identified five operating funding priorities for additional staff consideration and analysis for presentation at the September 8 Budget Workshop. The five operating funding priorities identified are as follows: i) Public Safety, ii) Derby, iii) Public Works, iv) Retail Development, and v) Economic Development. Within each priority the Council provided additional detail as to the type of day-to-day operations, core and/or management processes it would like to potentially increase capacity and capabilities to deliver increased levels of service.

The City Council consensus to affirm this discussion and desire for the September 8 Budget Workshop was to place this matter on Notice Council Business to approve this direction.
