WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City will join Playful Cities USA in celebrating Play Day by hosting a free family fun zone at the annual 4th Fest celebration July 4 at Dick's Sporting Goods Park.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that I, on behalf of City Council, hereby proclaim Monday, July 4, 2016 as a DAY OF PLAY in the City of Commerce City and that July is recognized as Parks and Recreation Month in the City of Commerce City and encourage all residents to share the benefits that come from parks and recreation.
