

ORDINANCE NO. 2768

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2026 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL AFFAIRS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$17,750 FOR COMMERCE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION PROJECT AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Local Affairs (“DOLA”) administers the Civic Solutions Hub – Innovative Local Government Workforce Solutions Pilot Program, a new grant initiative designed specifically to help local governments test, develop, and scale innovative approaches to today’s most pressing workforce challenges; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this pilot program is to identify, test, and evaluate new workforce strategies that can strengthen and sustain local governments operations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) applied for funding to improve recruitment and retention efforts for public safety staff (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded Civic Solutions Hub grant funding in the amount of \$17,750 to implement the Project, which was not originally included in the 2026 adopted budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be supported and authorized by law and in the best interests of and necessary for the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

SECTION 2. Amendment. An amendment is made to the 2026 Budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of funds from DOLA in the amount of \$17,750 (Fund 180).

SECTION 3. Repealer. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
