

Accountability Timeline for Adams 14 School District

Last Updated Feb. 10, 2022



Anticipated Activities, Board Meetings, and Public Comment Opportunities

The State Board of Education values hearing from the community during the accountability hearing process. When a formal hearing is noticed for a district or school, the State Board of Education sets a formal public comment period beginning at least 30 days before the hearing and ending a week prior to the hearing.

The State Board currently has two accountability cases from Adams 14 School District: one directed at the district as a whole and another directed at Central Elementary School.

On Feb. 4, the State Board of Education set a hearing on the district for April 2022.

On Feb, 10, the State Board of Education rescheduled a hearing on Central Elementary School for April 2022 (previously March 2022), to follow the district’s hearing. The state board also requested that the State Review Panel revisit Central Elementary School and issue a new report and recommendation ahead of the April hearing.

By mid-February, the State Board Office will issue a scheduling notification, setting the specific dates and times for the district’s and Central Elementary School’s April hearings. The formal notice will detail the process for the accountability hearings, including the process for public comment.

Public comment is currently being accepted for the April 2022 hearing on Central Elementary School. Information on how to submit public comment is available on the [State Board of Education website](#).

All public comment will be compiled for the board and will not be responded to individually.

Feb. 9-11, 2022	The State Review Panel conducted a site visit to the district. The report from that visit will be shared at the March State Board of Education meeting.
Feb. 9-10, 2022 (State Board of Education Meeting)	CDE staff provided a progress monitoring update on Adams 14 and an update on the status of the board’s directed actions. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The state board members shared their requests for a district proposal for the April hearing.• The state board moved the Central Elementary hearing to April and requested an updated State Review Panel visit. Mid-February 2022	Public comment period for Adams 14 district-wide hearing opens. Exact date will be set after the State Board Office issues a scheduling notification.
March 9-10, 2022 (State Board of Education Meeting)	CDE staff will provide an update on current progress monitoring activities and will share the report from the State Review Panel visit to Adams 14.
