Process for Public Art Donations in Public Areas

- Cultural Council will use the public art selection process, established by the Public Art Master Plan when deciding to accept or decline donations of artwork.
- The Cultural Council will review recommendations of the art selection committee and present them to the Commerce City City Council for final review and approval.





Project Details – Greenway Guardians

Youth-led process

- Six youth, ages 10-15, acted as the art selection committee to select artist and concept.
- Worked in collaboration with artist to create the piece, titled "Protecting Commerce."
- Participated in trash pick ups to gather art materials (128 pounds of trash throughout the process)

Project funded by Metro Football Stadium District funds and Quality Community Foundation grant.

Artwork Donation Arrangement


- Sand Creek Regional Greenway proposed donating artwork to Commerce City's public art collection.

Commerce


- Cultural Council approved accepting artwork and installing at Eagle Pointe Recreation Center on Feb. 18, 2025.
