What is the CAPER?

The City of Commerce City's (C3) Consolidated Plan is carried out through Annual Action Plans, which provide a concise summary of the actions, activities, and the specific federal and non-federal resources that will be used each year to address the priority needs and goals identified by the Consolidated Plan. The City reports on accomplishments and progress toward Consolidated Plan goals in the Consolidated **Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER).**

The CAPER is required by HUD

The CAPER includes:

- A report on resources and investments
- A report on goals and outcomes
- A report on progress towards providing affordable housing
- Demographic composition of individuals and families assisted
- Citizen participation efforts

Households Assisted with Housing Programs

There were 105 households served through City housing programs.

- Rental Assistance = 68 households (DVV)
- Homeowner Rehab = 37 households (MHRP & PAT)

Income Levels for CDBG program (reported income):

- Extremely Low-Income = 12 households (11%)
- Low-Income = 83 households (79%)
- Moderate-Income = 10 households (10%)



Racial and Ethnic Composition of Persons Assisted

CDBG

The number of persons served through the City's CDBG program reporting race/ethnicity was 597 persons (housing & public services).

- 467 persons were White (78.2%)
- 57 persons were Black (9.5%)
- 10 persons were Asian (1.7%)
- 50 persons were Other or Multi-racial (8.7%)
- All other races combined were less than 2%
- 317 persons identified ethnically as Hispanic (53.1%)
