 - ✓ Antifreeze processed and sold for recycled reuse
 - ✓ Washer fluid removed and sold for reuse
 - ✓ Gas and diesel fuels reused in Company vehicles
 - ✓ Freon collected and sold for reuse
 - ✓ Batteries stored & sold for reuse or recycled
 - ✓ Tires are sold for reuse or shipped for recycling
 - ✓ All recycled parts drained before storage
