

**RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY
PROCUREMENT POLICY**

NO. 2018-92

WHEREAS, in 2014, the City Council of the City of Commerce City, Colorado (“City”) enacted a Procurement Policy by resolution to establish standards for the City’s procurement of goods and services in a manner that reflects the City Values;

WHEREAS, as stewards of the public trust, the City Council established the following goals for the Procurement Policy: (i) obtaining the best value for Commerce City taxpayers; (ii) acquiring the highest quality goods and services; (iii) achieving peak results; (iv) providing an open process; (v) ensuring effectiveness and efficiency through a streamlined procurement process; and (vi) retaining adequate controls over procurement; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend and update the Procurement Policy to continue to achieves the foregoing goals in a manner reflective of the City Values and in the best interests of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Procurement Policy is amended, effective January 1, 2019, as shown in Exhibit A to this resolution.
2. The Procurement Policy, as amended by this resolution, is in the best interests of the public and necessary for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare.
3. The Procurement Policy, as amended, is enacted in accordance with Section 7.4(m) of the City’s Charter, which permits the City Council to approve, on recommendation of the City Manager, rules and regulations governing purchases on behalf of the City.
