- 1. Goal #1: Increase total attendance at the Music in the Park series by 10% (4,300+ total attendees).
 - *Hire two familiar bands and two new bands.*
 - Consider hosting closing concert in Downtown Derby.
- 2. Goal #2: Attend five community events through enhanced partnerships with the city and other boards and commissions.
 - Host a craft and booth at MiniCon event.
 - Sponsor a car show at a city event.
 - Participate in DEI Commission's annual Juneteenth event.
 - Sponsor the city's annual Hispanic Heritage Celebration.
 - Explore involvement in other events such as Memorial Day, Fall Fest, and Adams City Homecoming.
- 3. Goal #3: Activate Commerce City artists through engaging art activations.
 - Community art building projects at Music in the Park and Hispanic Heritage events.
 - Plan America 250/Colorado 150 event in collaboration with the Arsenal.
- 4. Goal #4: Find new ways to fundraise through creative new programming.
 - Selling canvases and artwork to generate revenue.
 - Pursue additional grants that we haven't applied to previously.
 - Request an increase in annual sponsorship from City Council.
