AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2021 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT FUNDS FOR \$189,600 FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF AUTOMATED TRAFFIC SIGNAL PERFORMANCE MEASURES (ATSPM) AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

An amendment is made to the 2021 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) grant in the amount of \$189,600 and the expenditure thereof is authorized to implement Automated Traffic Signal Performance Measures (“ATSPM”) at twenty-three existing signalized intersections along the following corridors: 56th Avenue, Quebec Parkway, Highway 2, 104th Avenue, and Tower Road, and for such other purposes as authorized by the intergovernmental agreement with CDOT related to such funds. (Fund 395).
