

**RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT  
AMONG THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, THE CITY OF THORNTON, THE  
COUNTY OF ADAMS, COLORADO, AND THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT  
OF TRANSPORTATION REGARDING THE WIDENING AND  
ENHANCEMENT OF THE 104<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE BRIDGE OVER THE SOUTH  
PLATTE RIVER**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (the “City”), the City of Thornton (“Thornton”), the County of Adams, Colorado (the “County”) (the City, Thornton and the County are collectively referred to hereinafter as the “Local Agencies”), and the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) propose to enter into the attached Intergovernmental Agreement (the “IGA”) to provide for the widening and enhancement (the “Improvements”) of the 104th Avenue bridge over the South Platte River;

WHEREAS, CDOT currently has funding available to construct the Improvements;

WHEREAS, the Local Agencies have agreed to reimburse CDOT, in the manner and amounts set forth in the IGA, for the costs incurred by CDOT to construct the Improvements; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with CDOT requirements, the City is obliged, and the City Council agrees, to evidence through the passage of a City Council resolution both the City’s approval of the IGA and authorization of the amount of the City’s financial contribution to the construction of the Improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City is hereby authorized to enter into the IGA
2. The City’s financial contribution to construction of the Improvements, as set forth in the IGA, is hereby approved.
3. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign and attest the IGA on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
