

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN CITY OF COMMERCE CITY AND THE
REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City (“City”) desires to establish a bus transit service route between various points within the southern portions of the City and has accepted a grant from the Regional Transportation District (“RTD”) to do so; and

WHEREAS, the City and RTD wish to enter into an agreement attached hereto regarding funding, design and construction of various transit related improvements along the proposed route (“Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, RTD requires the City to pass a resolution authorizing the City to enter into the Agreement, and the City is authorized pursuant to § 29-1-203, C.R.S., as amended, and Section 4.13 of the Charter of the City of Commerce City to enter into intergovernmental agreements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby finds and determines that approval of the Agreement is and shall be in the best interest of the residents of the City.
2. The Agreement, substantially in the form attached, is hereby approved.
3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign, and the City Clerk to attest, the Agreement, substantially in the form attached on behalf of the City.
4. This resolution repeals and replaces Resolution 2016-98, which authorized a prior version of the intergovernmental agreement.
