

**RESOLUTION REGARDING COUNCIL POLICY #CP-14
RELATIVE TO RESTRICTION ON CITY EMPLOYMENT
OF FORMER ELECTED OFFICIALS
NO. 2014-01**

WHEREAS, this City Council has received inquiries concerning City employment of former elected officials as provided in Council Policy #CP-14; and

WHEREAS, this City Council has reviewed Council Policy #CP-14 as it pertains to the restriction on City employment for former elected City officials; and

WHEREAS, this City Council has determined that paragraph G of Council Policy #CP-14 needs to be amended; and

WHEREAS, this City Council finds and determines that amendment of Subparagraph 3 of Paragraph G of Council Policy #CP-14 is in the best interests of the City of Commerce City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The title of paragraph G of Council Policy #CP-14 is amended to read as follows:

G. ELECTED OFFICIALS NOT TO BE EMPLOYED AND RESTRICTION ON EMPLOYMENT OF FORMER ELECTED OFFICIALS.

SECTION 2. Subparagraph 3 of Section G of Council Policy #CP-14 is amended to read as follows:

3. The following restrictions on City employment shall apply:

- a. No City Council member, including the Mayor, or the City Manager shall, within one year of his/her office or employment, obtain employment with the City.
- b. No member of any City board, commission, authority or the Cultural Council shall, within _____ months of the termination of his/her office, obtain employment with the City.

SECTION 3. The remaining provisions of Council Policy #CP-14 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
