Background

- Council has directed to Staff to explore issue on several occasions
 - Initial request in May of 2016
 - Follow-up presentations in 2018 and 2020
 - No formal action taken by Council
- Chickens only allowed in ag zoned properties currently

Overview

- Allowing backyard hens would require significant Staff work
 - 1. Updates to Animal Code allowing chickens
 - 2. Updates to LDC to allow chickens in all zones and setting standards for chicken coops as accessory structures
 - 3. Development of permitting program
- Groundwork laid by previous efforts and informed by researched best practices



Animal Code Updates

 Update animal code to allow chickens as a domestic animal with conditions and regulations



LDC Updates

- Allow chicken coops as accessory structures
 - Create standards based on best practices

Allow chickens in residentially zoned areas



Permitting Program

Establishment of permitting program

• Ensure compliance with municipal code and standards
