*WHEREAS, Native American and Indigenous residents have enriched the diverse community of Commerce City through their participation in city government, the arts, religious and civil institutions, education and community organizations; and*

*WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City believes that all people deserve to be protected from bullying, harassment, discrimination, and health disparities; and convey a clear message that intolerance is not welcome in our community.*

*NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Commerce City hereby declares the month of November 2023 to be Native American Heritage Month in the City of Commerce City and encourages all residents to recognize the contributions made by members of the Native American and Indigenous Peoples community and to actively promote the principles of equality, liberty, and justice.*
