AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2021 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY TRANSFERRING \$350,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE FACILITIES FUND FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE FACILITY ASSESSMENT PRIORITY ONE PROJECTS AND DESIGN WORK RELATED TO THE ADA AUDIT AND AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURES THEREOF.
