

**RESOLUTION APPROVING INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH
URBAN DRAINAGE AND FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District (“District”) has committed to funding up to \$250,000 of the construction cost of improvements to the First Creek drainage channel associated with the widening of 104th Avenue;

WHEREAS, the City and the District desire to establish specific criteria with respect to funding and construction of the drainage improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines that approval and execution of the attached Agreement Regarding Final Design, Right-of-Way Acquisition and Construction of Drainage and Flood Control Improvements for First Creek at 104th Avenue (the “Intergovernmental Agreement”), which establishes such criteria, is and shall be in the best interest of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Intergovernmental Agreement is hereby approved.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sign and attest to the Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City of Commerce City.
