REQUEST

Adopt a resolution amending Council Policy #14 regarding the City Council ethics code.

BACKGROUND

On January 27, 2025, City Council received a presentation on adopting a Code of Ethics. The Code of Ethics would be codified into the City's municipal code and apply to elected and appointed officials, board and commissions members, and employees. City Council approved the first reading of Ordinance 2672, which adopts the Code of Ethics, on April 21. The second and final reading of Ordinance 2672 is scheduled to take place on May 19.

With the approval of Ordinance 2672, changes to City Council's Council Policies are needed. As such, this resolution has been drafted to repeal Council Policy #CP-14, where the previous ethics provisions were held.
