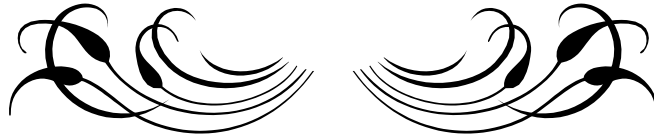

# Proclamation



*WHEREAS, Public Works Director Gregg Clements, a 36-year employee with the City of Commerce City, retired in September 2011; and*
