RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO APPOINT A CITY EMPLOYEE TO THE NORTH METRO YOUTH DIVERSION PROGRAM'S GOVERNING NORTH METRO COMMUNITY DIVERSION BOARD

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City), in partnership with other local government agencies formed the North Metro Youth Diversion Program ("Program") and established its North Metro Community Diversion Board ("Board"); and

WHEREAS, the growing numbers of youth and young criminal offenders involved in alcohol, illicit drugs or petty crime cause a direct detriment to the public safety, health and welfare of all participating members of this Program; and

WHEREAS, the Program provides a mechanism for first-time youth offenders or youths referred by schools, social services or families to receive education, intervention and training designed to avert repeat or future unlawful behavior; and

WHEREAS, the Program may reduce the work load of the Commerce City Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the Program is governed by the Board; and

WHEREAS, the City may appoint an employee to serve as a member of the Board:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Manager is authorized to appoint an employee of the City to the Board.
- 2. The term of such an appointment shall be for five (5) years unless the appointment is terminated earlier by the City Manager.
