FIRST READING OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2023 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE ADAMS COUNTY OPEN SPACE GRANT FOR A SINGLE RIDER GOLF CART IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,250 AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

### **Summary and Background Information:**

As stewards of our public spaces, the PRG Department is focused on promoting resident health, safety and education through a variety of relevant programs and services for the community. One of our goals is to continue to activate the city with more amenities designed to promote fitness and wellness, including accessibility. Adams County agrees to disburse grant funds to the Applicant to provide reimbursement for the payment of project costs upon successful completion of the Project, or on a quarterly basis. Itemized Reimbursement Requests are required for reimbursements. Should the Project take two full years to complete, the Reimbursement Request for the final period of the project must be received by August 9, 2025 to remain compliant with the Project Completion Date, as set forth above. Reimbursements disbursed from Adams County shall not exceed 69.92% of project costs incurred during the previous period with cumulative reimbursements totaling no more than \$13,250 based on a total project cost of \$18,950. The single rider golf cart is specifically designed for individuals with mobility challenges, allowing golfers to access the course and play the game without the physical strain of walking or pushing a traditional golf cart. This electric cart offers independence for golfers with disabilities as they do not need to rely on a playing partner to drive or navigate the course. Single rider golf carts promote inclusivity, can boost the local economy, improves health and well-being, and enhances community engagement.

On March 27, 2023 Commerce City submitted an Adams County Open Space grant application in the amount of \$13,250 for a single rider golf cart. The total cost of the cart is \$18,950, with the city providing a match of \$5,700.

On August 9, 2023 the Adams County Board of County Commissioners awarded \$13,250 in Adams County Open Space grant funds for Open Space Restoration. Staff expects to purchase the single rider golf cart in 2023.
