

ORDINANCE NO. 2675

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2025 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF OFF-SYSTEM BRIDGE PROGRAM GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$720,000 FOR REHABILITATION OF THE BRIDGE AT TOWER ROAD AND THIRD CREEK AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Off-System Bridge Program's primary objective is to inventory, inspect, evaluate, replace and rehabilitate major structures on public roads owned by Colorado counties and municipalities;

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce City ("City") applied for funding in 2023 for the rehabilitation of the bridge at Tower Road and Third Creek to maintain safety and capacity on Tower Road; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded federal funding from the Colorado Department of Transportation ("CDOT") in 2023 through the Off-System Bridge Grant Program to rehabilitate the bridge at Tower Road and Third Creek.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Findings. The recitals to this ordinance are incorporated as findings of the City Council. This ordinance is found to be necessary for the preservation of public health, safety, and welfare and in public interest.

SECTION 2. Authorization. The 2025 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado, is amended to recognize Off-System Bridge Program grant funds totaling \$720,000 and to appropriate such funds in the Capital Expenditures Fund (Fund 395) for a total of \$720,000.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All other ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent or conflicting with this ordinance or any portion hereof are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage on second and final reading.
