AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2013 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO, BY TRANSFERRING A PORTION OF THE UNENCUMBERED FUND BALANCE IN THE CIPP FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$663,786, FOR PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT AND PARKS AND RECREATION CAPITAL PROJECT PLANNING AND PREPARATION AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

There is hereby transferred from the unencumbered fund balance of the CIPP Fund the amount of \$663,786 to pay for Parks & Recreation capital project planning/preparation in the amount of \$163,786, and for Pavement Management in the amount of \$500,000 (Fund 395).
