

WHEREAS, Commander Charles Baker retired from the City of Commerce City with 36 years of service on April 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Commander Baker was responsible for the administrative functions within support services and personnel including, the police records, youth services and special operations units and managed the police department's \$15.2 million budget; and

WHEREAS, during his career Commander Baker served as a police officer for six years, sergeant for 11 years and served as acting Chief of Police for two years; and

WHEREAS, Commander Baker represented the city in professional organizations such as the North Metro Drug Task Force Board of Governors, Police Liability Committee, Commerce Police Pension Board and the Adams County Patrol Commanders Association; and

WHEREAS, Commander Baker was selected as the Chief of Police for the City of Cody, Wyoming, following a nationwide search that yielded 77 applicants and five finalists.
