CDBG-CV Fund Details

1. Recipient must have been financially impacted by COVID-19
2. Recipient must be Low – to – Moderate Income
3. Recipient must be a city resident

CDBG-CV Uses

Following the direction of the City, the CDBG will utilize \$220,000 of the CDBG-CV funding for Rent and Mortgage Assistance

- **\$173,000 in direct assistance**
- **\$25,000 estimated Subrecipient project delivery costs**
- **\$22,453 in City's administration**

80% of the funds available must be spent by 2023.



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Est. Households Assisted

Variables:

- Length of Assistance ~ 1-3 months
- Rent / Mortgage amounts

If \$1,500 = 116 Households

If \$2,000 = 87 Households

If \$2,500 = 70 Households

If \$3,000 = 58 Households
