AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2012 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO BY THE RECOGNITION OF THE DENVER REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (DRCOG) GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FOR THE STATION AREA MASTER PLAN AND THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

An amendment is made to the 2012 budget of the City of Commerce City, Colorado for the recognition of the funds from the Denver Regional Council of Government grant funds in the amount of \$100,000. The funds are to be used to create a Station Area Master Plan for the FasTracks North Metro Corridor.
